NOTE A: An FQHC can provide mental health services if it is licensed by OMH. New York is implementing APGS on an "opt-in" basis for FQHC's. Part 599 clinic regulations apply to FQHC clinics licensed by OMH. However the APG payment methodology is not applicable to FQHCs except when the FQHC has voluntarily agreed to participate in the APG reimbursement system. A decision by an FQHC to participate in the APG system will apply to all of the services they deliver and not just mental health services.

NOTE B: Clinics may submit a supplemental bill under the Medicaid Physician Fee Schedule ("physician add-on") when a psychiatrist or psychiatric nurse practitioner spends at least 15 minutes participating in the provision of services being provided by another licensed practitioner or when the service is provided fully by a psychiatrist or NPP.

NOTE C: "Clinic Professional Staff" – Psychiatrist, MD, LMSW, LCSW, Psych (includes unlicensed if working for public entity), RN, LPN, NPP, LCAT, LMFT, LMHC, Licensed Psychoanalyst, PA (physical health only unless OMH approved training), Limited Permit staff, Students within approved SED programs, Non-licensed staff including qualified peer advocates and family advisors), CRC, CASAC, OT)

NOTE D: If a mental health provider admits a person to, for example, an outpatient mental health clinic, and the person also has a substance use diagnosis, isn't the clinic providing substance use services that require an operating certificate from OASAS?
No. Mental Hygiene law Section 32.05 provides that no provider of services shall engage in the provision of outpatient services for persons with chemical dependency without having been issued an operating certificate from OASAS. However, if an outpatient mental health provider admits a person who meets the criteria for admission to the outpatient program, it is providing outpatient mental health services to the person, not chemical dependency services. In this respect, the person's co-occurring substance use disorder is being managed in the course of the provision of mental health services, but the person is not being provided with chemical dependency outpatient services that require OASAS licensure.
