

## Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) Continuum of Care Pilot Training & Technical Assistance (TA) Fact Sheet

The MayaTech Corporation, through the SAMHSA-HRSA Center for Integrated Health Solutions, provides training and technical assistance (TA) to SAMHSA's MAI-CoC grantees. MayaTech's TA coordinators can help identify TA needs, and upon approval by the Government Project Officer (GPO), arrange for training and technical assistance.

### **Why request TA?**

Training and TA specific to mental health, substance abuse treatment and prevention are designed to assist grantees with improving the implementation, ongoing operations, and evaluation of their MAI-CoC program.

TA is available for grantees to:

- Facilitate program success
- Enhance program operations
- Improve efforts to measure program outcomes
- Improve client outcomes
- Sustain program efforts

### **How is TA provided?**

TA is provided using several different methods, including:

- Site visits
- Web-based trainings
- Conference calls

A TA coordinator will follow up after every TA and discuss any additional areas of concern.

### **How to request TA:**

- Discuss your TA needs with your GPO **prior** to completing a TA request form.
- Complete the TA request form and submit it to your GPO for review and approval.
- The GPO submits all TA requests to the MayaTech TA coordinator.
- All TA requests **must be approved by your GPO** before a TA coordinator can process the request.
